3. Pennsylvania's Fair Share Act became law in 2011. Since then, defendants in civil cases have been required to pay only their fair share of a verdict, where before, a defendant could posse held responsible for an entire verdict even if only 1 percent at fault! Over the course of however, Pennsylvania Appellate Courts have handed down decisions that have weakened Act and strayed from original legislative intent. The high court has found that the apportion of fault in the Fair Share Act does not apply to strict liability asbestos cases (Roverano v. Jo Crane, Inc). The Superior Court also determined recently that the act only applies when a plaintiff is found to be without any negligence at all (Spencer v. Johnson).
